This year we will be using an **online only** ordering system for Book Packs for 2022 with our stationery supplier Paperchase Office National.

There will be **NO** collection day at the school. Prep, Year 1 and Year 2 packs will be delivered to the classroom. Year 3 – Year 9 orders will be delivered free of charge to your nominated address before the start of Term 1 2022 if placed before the 13th December 2021. **Please note our delivery drivers can not deliver to PO Boxes - a physical address is required.**

Please place your order online no later than 13th December 2021 to guarantee your order is delivered prior to the start of Term 1.

Orders placed after 13th December 2021 will incur a \$10 packaging and handling charge and are not guaranteed to be delivered before school starts.

Online Ordering Procedure

- 1. Go to http://booklist.paperchase.com.au
- 2. Enter the correct school access code depending on year level for 2022:
 - Prep, Year 1, Year 2 (delivered to class) BTSBROOKP2
 - Years 3 9 (home delivered) BTSBROOK39
- 3. Click 'Create Order',
- 4. Enter students first and last name, choose year level for 2022 from the drop-down list and follow the prompts to place your order.

Please check your E-mail for order confirmation and receipt. If you do not receive email confirmation, please contact Paperchase directly to confirm your order was placed correctly.

PLEASE NOTE: All packs must be pre-paid. Payment must be made during the online ordering process, by Visa or Mastercard (credit card or debit card accepted). ZIP Pay also available*

Payment will be processed at time of ordering.

If you elect not to purchase the booklist through Paperchase please ensure children come to school on the first day with the required materials.
