COORDINATOR

The Service Coordinator serves as your initial point of contact, playing a crucial role in crafting a tailored program that caters to the unique needs and interests of your children.

Additionally, the Coordinator takes on the responsibility of ensuring the safety and well-being of the children, creating a secure and nurturing environment.



2IC

The Second In Charge (2IC) assumes a supportive role to the Service Coordinator, providing assistance in programming and administrative tasks. In the absence of the Service Coordinator, the 2IC takes charge, ensuring the seamless continuity of service operations.



EDUCATOR

The Educator plays a pivotal role in the daily experience of the children through running engaging activities and clubs that captivate their interest. The Educator actively supports children in their educational journey through play.



ENROLMENTS AND BOOKINGS

A completed enrolment form is required for all families. The best way to enrol is online.

Upon confirmation of your enrolment, login credentials for our online portal, Xplor, will be sent to you. We accommodate both casual and permanent bookings. Should you require any assistance, just reach out by email or phone.

SIGNING YOUR CHILD IN AND OUT

Signing in and out your child is easy through the Xplor Home app. It's essential that an authorised adult picks up your child. You have the flexibility to manage authorised individuals by adding them to your Xplor profile.

LATE PICK-UP

A late pick-up fee of \$1.00 per minute is charged once the service close time has passed.

CANCELLATION FEES

A cancellation fee will be applied if a session is not cancelled prior to 24 hours of the booking. The cancellation fee will be charged as the full fee of the booking, whether your booking is permanent or casual for that session. If you are eligible for Child Care Subsidy (CCS), you will only pay for the gap fee for up to 42 absences in a financial year. Cancellations can be completed via your Xplor Home app, by texting your program phone, or by email. Please see kellyclub.com.au/terms-and-conditions for more details.

MEDICATION AND IMPORTANT INFO

Let us know if your child needs to take medication during our program. We will ask you to fill out a Medical Consent Form to ensure your child gets the right dosage at the right time. All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide:

A completed Medical Action Plan signed by a doctor and with a colour photo of your child.

Medication must come in it's original packaging and labelled with the child's name, required dosage, time, date, and storage requirements.

Ensure you keep your contact details including emergency contacts up-to-date in case of emergencies.

PAYMENTS

Kelly Club makes it easy for you to pay for your OSHC services through Direct Debit. You can set up automatic payment when you enrol or through Xplor. Payment is required within 7 days of the week of attendance. An online statement is issued and emailed weekly.

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY

The Australian Government provides significant fee relief to Australian families via the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) program.

If you qualify for CCS, you can put it towards your Kelly Club care. This means you can get up to a 90% reduction and will only pay the "out-of-pocket" costs for your children to attend.


